INTRODUCTION TO HISTORY DATABASE – DATASET: HISTORY

The HISTORY data set includes two types of "extra" information about certain VATS patients. In general, these data are not available on the study forms, but were obtained through queries to the sites. Each record in HISTORY has two variables: ID (patient ID) and CODE (code for type of extra information). One set of codes (6, 11, 13, 21) documents patients who were enrolled in the VATS study and then retrospectively found to be ineligible. The other set of codes (902, 903) gives a finer breakdown of lifetime history of ARV use prior to enrollment, for patients whose Form 3 indicates 0 to 6 months of use. (This category on Form 3 does not distinguish patients with no use from patients with some use.) The codes have the following interpretations.

- 6 Retrospectively ineligible, because not CMV+ at baseline
- 11 Retrospectively ineligible, because of prior transfusion
- 13 Retrospectively ineligible, because of starting one or more new ARVs within the two weeks prior to enrollment
- 21 Retrospectively ineligible, because of starting one or more new systemic immunomodulators within the two weeks prior to enrollment
- 902 Had no history of ARV use prior to enrollment
- 903 Had some history of ARV use prior to enrollment
